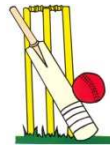

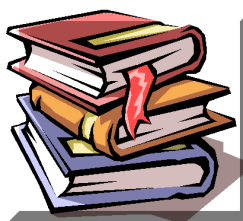

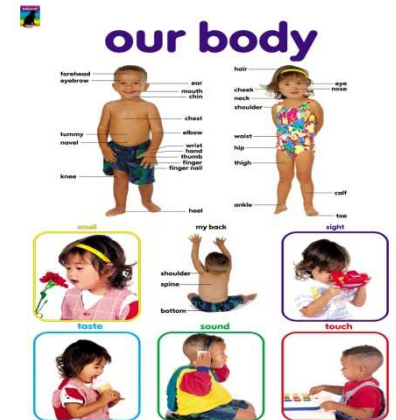

The system involves 5 fields of development in a pupil:

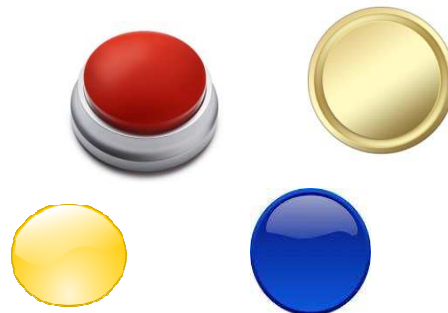
behaviour and responsibility;
