Schools are always in need of eager helpers, and it is a great way to get to know the parents and staff, and to get a good feel of the school.

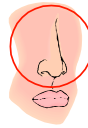

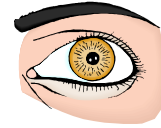

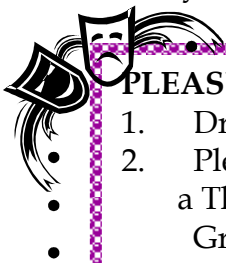
