RE: Lice

Dear Parents,

There has again been an outbreak of head lice in school children in the Goldfields.

Unless treatment is started immediately, and carried out thoroughly, the lice and their eggs will not be removed. The lice may easily be passed from one child to another while participating in daily activities. They may drop off onto brushes, combs, hats, scarves and pillows. If those articles are shared, lice quickly find their way into the new owner's hair. Other members of the family need to be checked regularly, as well as the affected child, even after treatment.

PREVENTION IS BETTER THAN CURE

Wash, brush and comb hair regularly and only use your own toiletry articles. Do not share hats. Follow the recommended treatment, irrespective of whether your child has lice or not.

Lice can be destroyed quickly by using Quellada lotion and Escabiol which are obtainable from your chemist. Follow the instructions on the label carefully. Care must be taken not to use other forms of insecticide. Clothing must be treated by ironing with a *hot* iron especially where seams are present.

Please remember that the presence of lice and nits is NOT a reflection of the degree of cleanliness of the person or household concerned. Lice and nits actually prefer clean hair!
